#### Mark Haddon

Mark Haddon is a British writer who has written novels, graphic novels, non-fiction and poetry. He was born in Northampton in 1962 and after university he started working with children and adults with mental and physical disabilities. This experience probably inspired his most famous novel *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night Time*, published in 2003. The novel, which has won a lot of prizes, is the story of an autistic boy, who, after he has found a dead dog in his neighbour's garden, wants to find out who has killed it, so the novel becomes a detective story. The novel has been very successful and has appeared in many languages and has also had a theatre adaptation. After this novel he has written six more and has also illustrated children's books. Mark Haddon continues writing and is also professor of creative writing at Oxford University.
